2022 Municipal Elections

A regular election will be held Tuesday, October 4th at the Coffman Cove Library for the purpose of filling Council Seats F & G, both 3-year terms. Polls will be open from 8 am – 8 pm. Candidates for office must file a declaration of candidacy form with the City Clerk no later than 2 pm on Tuesday, September 6th.

Harbor Rate Scale Amendments

- Floating Slips: \$17/foot annually, with an annual rate increase of \$2/year, every other year for the next 10 years, beginning October 2022 and ending October 2032.
- Skiff Ramp Slips: \$15/foot annually.

Did You Know?

Alaska had four time zones until October 30, 1983. At the state's request, the federal government reduced the time zones from four to two. The state is now predominantly on Alaska time, or one hour earlier than Pacific. The only residents of the state not on Alaska time are in the Aleutian Island communities of Atka, Adak, Shemya, Attu, and on Saint Lawrence Island.
