Prudhoe Bay is the largest oil field in North America – Alaska has produced more than 17 billion barrels of oil and 13 billion cubic feet of natural gas. Because Alaska produces the most amount of oil in the U.S., the industry supports 1/3 of all Alaska jobs, generating 110,000 jobs throughout the state. Alaska has collected \$157 billion from oil since 1959!
