

**City of Coffman Cove
Resolution 11-09**

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING AN APPLICATION TO THE DENALI
COMMISSION FOR A ROADS AND WATERFRONT PROJECT NOMINATION**

WHEREAS, the Coffman Cove City Council has identified a need for replacement of the drive down ramp (bridge) to the dock, and

WHEREAS, the Denali Commission funded a dock expansion grant which was completed in March 2010, and

WHEREAS, during the final design and work it was discovered the bridge was unsafe for forklifts and heavily loaded pickup trucks, and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska Department of Transportation has two harbor projects, one in Angoon and one in Hoonah, that will generate two surplus bridges either one which will fit our needs, and

WHEREAS, Coffman Cove could work with the contractor to obtain and install one of the bridges at Coffman Cove by fall of 2011 thereby cutting costs, and

WHEREAS, Coffman Cove could move the existing bridge at Coffman Cove to the Charter Dock to be limited to 4 wheeler traffic,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Coffman Cove City Council supports a funding request to the Denali Commission for a Transportation Program FY 2011 Roads and Waterfront Project Nomination.
