RESOLUTION 13-24

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING A HARBOR GANGWAY RAMP

WHEREAS, the City of Coffman Cove in cooperation with State of Alaska Commerce, Community and Economic Development Grants to Municipalities has received funding for a Harbor Gangway Ramp, and

WHEREAS, the City of Coffman Cove has set a goal to exploit its potential to develop viable marine-based commercial and industrial businesses that support area fisheries and a budding tourism market, and

WHEREAS, the ramp, 100' in length and 6' wide, is covered to keep the city from having to perform snow removal, and constructed of aluminum which requires little maintenance, and

WHEREAS, it is estimated the harbor facilities provide 49 jobs in the community, and

WHEREAS, the pedestrian and ATV accessible ramp would allow access to moorage for 10 boats as well as our baby Chinook Salmon fish pens, and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the Coffman Cove City Council is in favor of purchasing and installing a pre-engineered gangway ramp from the shore to an existing dock.
