**RESOLUTION 14-13**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF COFFMAN COVE AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION  
IN THE FEDERAL LAND ACCESS GRANT PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of Coffman Cove wishes to improve the unpaved section of Loggers Lane up to the point at which City utilities end; and

**WHEREAS**, paving our City streets is a top priority for the City of Coffman Cove; and

**WHEREAS**, it is recognized that the existing road was not constructed to accommodate a residential area with high volumes of traffic accessing Forest Service land; and,

**WHEREAS**, the dust from the gravel road poses a health hazard for community members and makes poor visibility a safety hazard for motorists; and

**WHEREAS**, the cost associated with the maintenance of Loggers Lane is a financial strain on the City of Coffman Cove; and


**WHEREAS**, the City of Coffman Cove recognizes that improving Loggers Lane with pavement would result in a significant annual cost savings and enhanced safety; and

**WHEREAS**, we are an applicant for a grant in the amount of \$409,635 under the Federal Land Access Program.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT** the City Administrator of the City of Coffman Cove is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute any and all documents required for granting and managing funds on behalf of this organization.

The Mayor is authorized to execute subsequent amendments to said grant agreement to provide for adjustments to the project within the scope of services or tasks, based upon the needs of the project.
