

**CITY OF COFFMAN COVE
RESOLUTION 15-07**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF COFFMAN COVE WITH RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE USE OF
TITLE II FUNDING ALLOCATING MAINTENANCE OF IMPORTANT LOCAL USFS ROADS ON
PRINCE OF WALES ISLAND**

WHEREAS, the Prince of Wales Resource Advisory Committee (RAC) which makes recommendations to the US Forest Service on the use of Title II funding from the Secure Schools Act, recommended allocating \$150,000 toward the maintenance of important local USFS roads on Prince of Wales Island, and

WHEREAS, while the funding is small compared to the need, the money is an opportunity to make some improvements to roads that our residents use, and

WHEREAS, the RAC would like each Prince of Wales community to list the highest priority local USFS roads, and

WHEREAS, the City of Coffman Cove recommends the following:

1. Priority #1 – The back end of the Trumpeter 3030519 Road is slated for closure. This road is used locally for hunting a wood cutting with an emphasis on wood cutting.
2. Priority #2 – The back end of Lower Coffman 3030519 Road is slated for closure. This road is used locally for hunting and wood cutting with an emphasis on wood cutting.
3. Priority #3 – The back-side of refrigerator 3000336 Road is an open Forest Service road in need of maintenance and is a priority to be kept open. This road is used locally for hunting.
4. Priority #4 – The Luck Lake Eagle Creek 3030110/112 is classified as a National Forest Trail/OVH route that has been closed. It is important for wood cutting, hunting and access to Eagle Creek.
5. Priority #5 – The Luck Two 3000333 Road is slated for storage (closure). It is an important road for hunting.


WHEREAS, the City of Coffman Cove recognizes that while the list we develop may well include project costs beyond the funding available this year, if Congress reauthorizes the Secure Rural Schools program, and the POW RAC again recommends funding for maintaining USFS roads, we may be able to turn the list in again next year for additional road maintenance projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the City Council of Coffman Cove and residents recommend the above named roads as their priority.
