**RESOLUTION 14-01**

**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE CITY OF COFFMAN COVE PURCHASING A  
GEO-THERMAL HEAT PUMP SYSTEM FOR THE COFFMAN COVE CLINIC**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Coffman Cove recognizes that the cost of operating a ground source heat pump is approximately half the cost of operating a diesel boiler system, and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Coffman Cove is supplied electricity by an Island wide grid that utilizes hydropower which means the electric ground source heat pump would be utilizing a renewable resource, and


**WHEREAS**, the City of Coffman Cove will assume financial responsibility for the Geo-Thermal heat pump and associated equipment after the September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2013 deadline, and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Coffman Cove recognizes that any part of the Geo-Thermal heat installation project left unfinished at the September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2013 deadline will be finished and paid for by the City of Coffman Cove, and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Coffman Cove recognizes that any part of the Coffman Cove Clinic construction project that is left unfinished by the deadline, as a result of designating funds to the geothermal component, will become the City's financial responsibility to finish.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the City of Coffman Cove is in agreement with the Denali Commission that a Geo-Thermal heating system would be cost efficient and also a reliable heat source for the Coffman Cove Clinic.
