A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF COFFMAN COVE TO APPLY FOR
ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT PROGRAM (FEMA)

WHEREAS, the City of Coffman Cove has an all-Volunteer Fire Department and EMT response team; and,

WHEREAS, the Volunteer Fire Department response to a 15 square mile radius of community, as well assisting other communities on Prince of Wales Island with fires; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Coffman Cove owns two fire vehicles, one of which does not work (1956 model), another that is wearing out quickly (1976 model); and,

WHEREAS, Training is needed for the Fire Department Volunteers; and,


WHEREAS, FEMA has an Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program that is currently open for a grant application to be submitted by December, 6, 2013.


WHEREAS, The City of Coffman Cove and Volunteer Fire Department have funds available for the 5% match; and,
