Home Insurance Rates

They should have been lowered

A member of the community asked that I remind folks to make sure that your home insurance policy rates take into account our new PPC classification. PPC stands for Public Protection Classification and is a tool used by insurance companies to rate Fire Departments based on a scale of 1 – 10, ten being the worst or least likely to stop a house fire. The rating procedures and criteria are stringent and complicated. The fire department was evaluated in 2006 and was not able to achieve a classification of less than ten. In 2008, we started the slow process of working toward a better PPC and were able to obtain a 6 classification in 2013. The new PPC took effect April 1, 2014. I have the letter at City Hall to prove it and also provided it to all local insurance companies. That being said, when my commercial policy renewal came up in July, my rate had not changed. I found that the insurance company needed reminding and my rate was corrected immediately. Depending on your policy, your rates could have been cut by two thirds. For those of you who have never purchased home owners insurance, it may be time to look into it. Your policy could be as low as \$400 per year.

In order to maintain our new PPC, we will need volunteers to join the Fire Department Roster who are interested in participating in the drills and taking on some of the work. The Fire Department meets the last Saturday of every month, 9 a.m. at the Fire Hall.
