The transport vehicle still has a problem with front-end vibration at certain speeds. It has been to Schaub Ellis in Craig, and had the alignment checked as well as the tires balanced. This has been done monthly on our monthly meetings, and has not resolved the problem. I plan to ask Tracy Vaughn in Thorne Bay if he has any suggestions.
