Greetings from the Water World. Water usage has increased to about 20,000 gallons per day. That is standard for this time year due to the approaching busy summer season. There were a few water leaks detected during last months meter reading. Two leaks were at residences and were due to toilets that were running continuously. There was also a leak found in the Church Camp water line that extends across the cove. That leak was repaired.

There was a new water/sewer service installed at Cheyney's subdivided lot.

There are several property owners in Chum Creek Drive Subdivision that have expressed interest in having water service extended up Chum Creek Drive. The property owners are looking for council's thoughts on making that happen.
